### 17.1 RAIL TRANSPORTATION

For rail transportation, pulp can be carried in curtain-side, containers and box wagons.

### 17.2 HANDLING

Pulp can be freighted either **palletised**, **baled** or in **reels**.

The preferred handling method are:

Palletised: Clamp or forklift.  
Baled pulp: Clamp or forklift.  
Reeled pulp: Clamp.

### 17.3 LOADING RESTRAINT

Pulp must not overhang the load platform.

### 17.4 STOWAGE

Pulp must be kept clean and dry at all times
